False Charges

ACIS

- The Jews accused Stephen of:
 - blasphemous words against Moses and against God.
 - speaking against this holy place and against the law.
 - saying that Jesus would destroy this place and change the customs Moses handed down.

False Charges

- Two main accusations:
 - Speaking against the temple = God.
 - Speaking against Moses = the law.

ACTS

- All who were sitting in the Sanhedrin <u>looked</u> <u>intently</u> at Stephen
 - saw that his face was like the face of an angel

 - Moses was rejected and became their ruler and deliverer by God.

ACTS

- God was with the people in the wilderness.
- •God was with the people in the promised land.
- God is not confined to the temple.

Stephen's Response

- The people consistently rejected God and his prophets.
- They had the outward signs of the covenant but their hearts remain unchanged.
- They rejected Jesus the Messiah.

Stephen's Death

ACIS

- The Sanhedrin refused to receive Stephen's correction.
- Stephen saw God's glory.
 - He entrusted himself to the Lord and prayed for those who stoned him.
- Persecution broke out against the church.

Persecution Breaks Out

ACIS

- When opposition arises, trust the Holy Spirit to give you wisdom to respond.
- Be on guard against a spirituality or selfrighteousness that causes you to miss God.
- Follow Christ's example of mercy in the midst of persecution.
