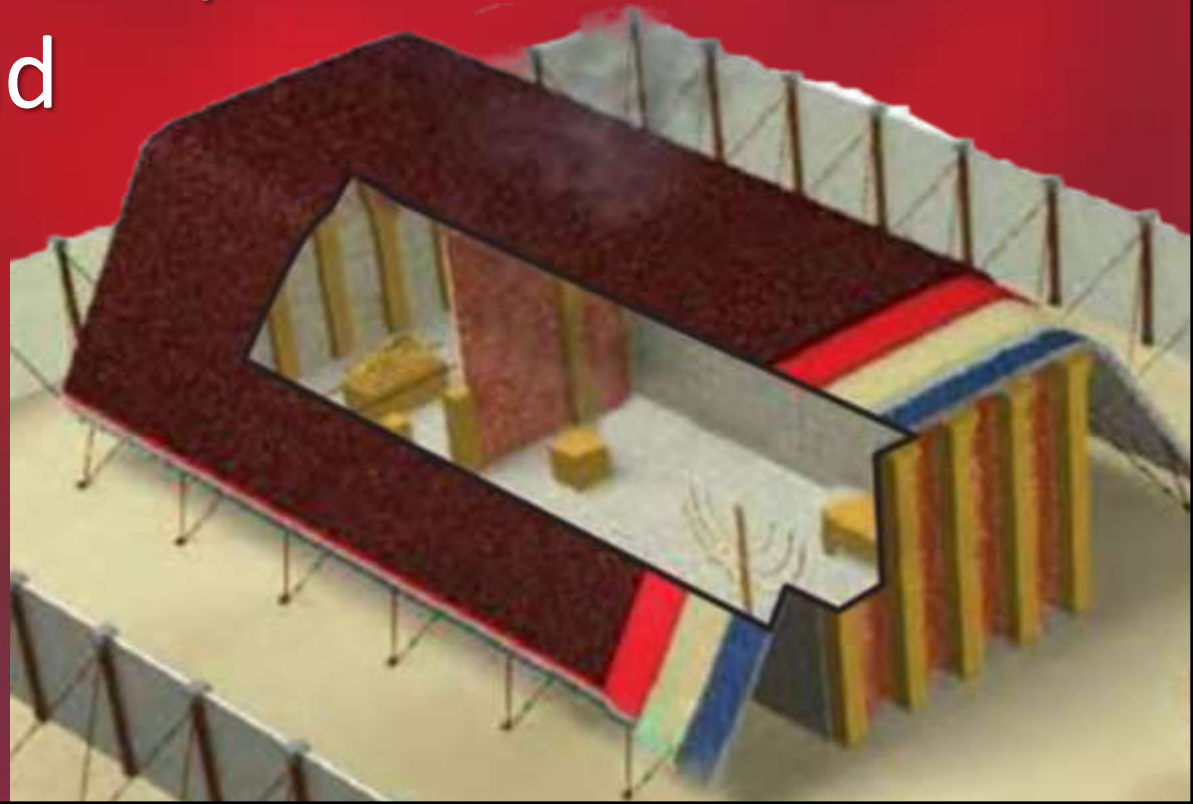
Preparation

- the first covenant
 - regulations for worship
 - earthly sanctuary



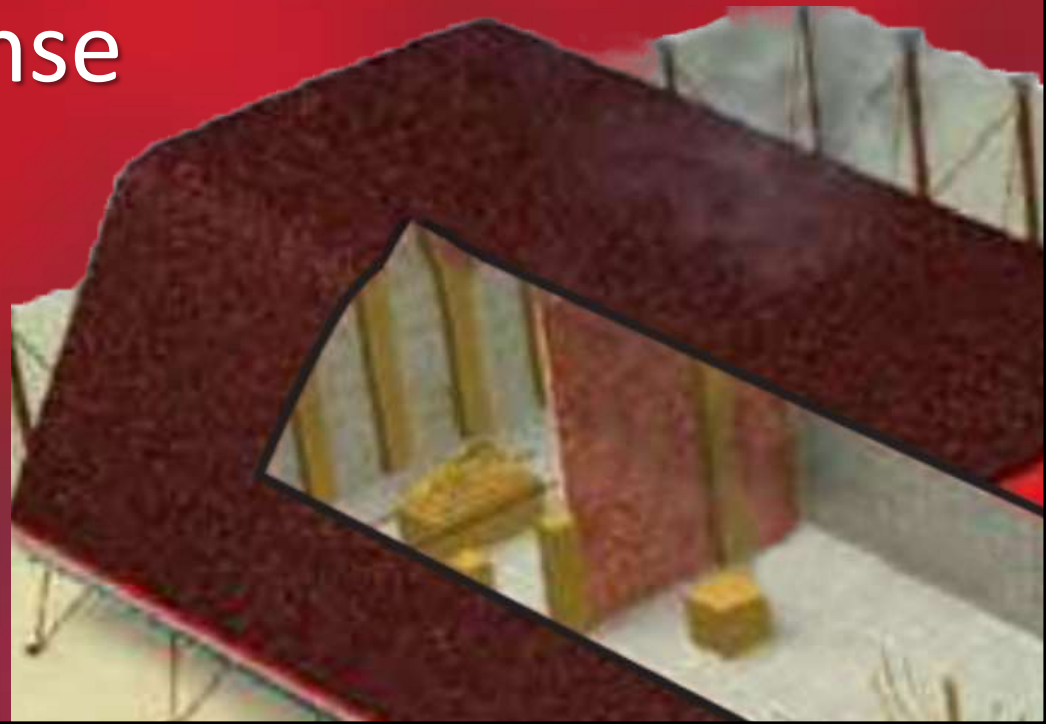
Preparation

- The Tabernacle
 - first room - Holy Place
 - lampstand
 - table



Preparation

- behind the second curtain
 - Most Holy Place
 - altar of incense
 - ark of the covenant



Preparation

- ark of the covenant
 - jar of manna
 - Aaron's staff
 - tablets of the covenant



Preparation

- The Holy Spirit was showing that
 - the way into the Most Holy Place had not yet been disclosed.
- the gifts and sacrifices were not able to clear the conscience of the worshiper
 - “perfect”

Redemption

- When Christ came...
 - he went through the greater and more perfect tabernacle...

Redemption

- he entered the Most Holy Place
 - once for all
 - by his own blood
- having obtained eternal redemption

Cleansing

- The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer...
 - sanctify...so that they are outwardly clean

Cleansing

- How much more
 - will the blood of Christ
 - who through the eternal Spirit
 - offered himself unblemished to God

Cleansing

- cleanse our consciences
 - from acts that lead to death
 - so that we may serve the living God

Cleansing

- If we confess our sins,
 - he is faithful and just
 - and will forgive us our sins
 - and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- 1 John 1:9

Inheritance

- Christ is the mediator of a new covenant
 - that those who are called
 - may receive the promised eternal inheritance

Inheritance

- now that he has died
 - to set them free
 - from the sins committed under the first covenant

- Redeems us from sin
- Cleanses our consciences
- Secures our eternal inheritance
