- We do not demand to be paid back for a wrong.
- We make an active choice to let the person go free.

Compassion

- The King
 - ordered the he and his wife and his children and all that he had be sold to repay the debt.

Compassion

- The King
 - The servant fell on his knees
 - begged
 - •Be patient with me,
 - and I will pay back everything

Compassion

- The King
 - took pity on him
 - · "compassion"

Compassion

- The Servant
 - His fellow servant fell to his knees and begged
 - Be patient with me,
 - and I will pay you back.

Compassion

- The Servant
 - But he refused
 - · "was not willing"
 - had the man thrown in prison until he could pay

Compassion

- •When we are wronged, it is easy to become callous and hard-hearted.
- We need to remain open and tender-hearted, ready to forgive.

Generosity

- Two debts
 - ten thousand talents
 - "zillions"
 - · a hundred denarii
 - 100 days wages

Generosity

- The king gave up an unfathomable amount of money.
- The servant was unwilling to give up anything.

Generosity

- Peter came to Jesus asked,
 - How many times shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him?
 - Up to seven times?

Generosity

- •I tell you
 - not seven times
 - but seventy-seven times

Generosity

• Forgiveness requires the abundant bestowal of grace and mercy.

Gratitude

 Shouldn't you have had mercy on your fellow servant just as I had on you?

Gratitude

- Colossians 3:12-13
 - Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and loved
 - clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience

Gratitude

- Colossians 3:12-13
 - · Bear with each other
 - and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another.
 - Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
